All in favor. Motion carried. This is the combo cup – same cup as we have for the club championship trophy voted in previously. Washington has purchased the cup with only SoCal, BC, and LA contributing. Still owing \$45 for the cup is Oregon, Sierra, Alberta, Nevada, Rocky Mountain, Idaho, Central Valley, and Arizona. Funds may be sent to Annie for distribution.

f. Central Valley proposed several series within the OTMX series but it was withdrawn.

g. Central Valley moved we run the +70 class Expert, Amateur, Novice, the 80 class, and the 60 Novice together in one race. Seconded by SoCal. Vote taken

14. Arizona:

a. International consider adding the local class as well as the International class on membership cards. No second.

b. Each rider must ride in 2 zones to qualify for the International awards. Change the number to a minimum of 4 rides rather than just 2 minimum. No second.

c. The total number of events scored/counted for determining overall finishing position will be based upon the number of events held as follows:

The most number of first place finishes will be utilized for breaking any ties at year end. If there is still a tie, the most number of moto wins will be used. Motion seconded and carried unanimously.

15. British Columbia – Don Tocher – asked why the SoCal chapter scheduled a 2 day event on the same weekend date as an IOTMX event. SoCal – Rich Kastner explained they have a tremendous schedule of their local events. Most local riders do not travel to International events. They would receive more points if they travel to OT events, but mostly do not travel.

16. Leroy asked if everyone was happy with the computer move up system? Don asked if there are 3 riders in a class/event then do all 3 riders get moved up? We did not have an answer. Annie will check it out.

17. Los Angeles, Jeff Hawthorne, suggested that if a rider only gets 4 motos at our events then they should be charged less than the riders who rides 5 motos.

18. Next meeting will be hosted by Central Valley and will be here at the Black Bear Diner on Sunday evening at 5:00 pm, September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
